3. Exchanging Personal Information: Common Tourism Scenarios

Scenario 1: Introductions & Basic Identity

At the airport check-in desk:

Agent: "Good morning. What is your name?"

You: "I am Maria Silva." / "My name is Maria Silva."

Agent: "Where are you from?"

You: "I am from Brazil." / "I'm Brazilian."

Meeting a fellow traveler:

Traveler: "Hi, I'm David. This is my wife, Sarah."

You: "Nice to meet you. We're Anna and Mark."

Scenario 2: Nationality & Origin

On a tour bus:

Guide: "So, where is everyone from? Are you all from the United States?"



You: "No, we are from Canada. They are from Australia."

At a hotel reception:

Receptionist: "Is this your first time in London?"

You: "Yes, it is. But my friend was here last year."

Scenario 3: Profession & Status

At a hostel common room:

Traveler: "What is your job?" / "What do you do?"

You: "I am a teacher. She is a student."

At a border control checkpoint:

Officer: "What is the purpose of your visit? Are you here for business or tourism?"

You: "It is for tourism. We are on holiday."

Scenario 4: Location & Feelings

Asking for directions:

You: "Excuse me, I am lost. Where is the Eiffel Tower?"

Local: "It is that way. You are very close!"

Expressing how you feel:

Friend: "Are you tired?"

You: "Yes, I am. But I'm also very excited! The museum was amazing."

3. Mini-Dialogues: Putting It All Together

Dialogue 1: Checking into a Hotel

Receptionist: "Good evening. What is your name, please?"

You: "It is Robert Chen."

Receptionist: "Thank you, Mr. Chen. Is this your first time in Tokyo?"

You: "No, it isn't. I was here two years ago for business."
