Course title: Tenses: the present tenses

What are the present tenses?

When do we use them?

In English grammar, we use present tense in tow forms:

- I- Simple present
- II- Present continuous

I-Simple present

A- **We use the simple present to talk about things in general.** We are not thinking only about the present. We use it to say that something happens all the time or repeatedly, or that something is true in general (general truth),

Examples

- ❑ The earth goes around the sun.
- ❑ Nurses take care of patients in hospitals.
- ❑ In Canada, most stores close at 6:00 p.m.
- ❑ I work in a bank. Barry works in a department store.

B- We use do/does to make questions and negative sentences:

do I/we/you/they] I/we/you/they **don't** } does he/she/it work · he/she/it
doesn't work

- Excuse me, do you speak English?
- "Would you like a cigarette?" "No, thanks. I don't smoke."
- What does this word mean? (not What means this word?)
- Rice doesn't grow in Alaska. (For questions see also next sessions)

E- We use the simple present when we say how often we do things:

- I get up at 8:00 every morning. (not am getting) How often do you go to the dentist?
- Ahmed doesn't go out very often.
- In the summer, Tom usually plays tennis twice a week.

F- Note that we say "Where do you come from?" (=Where are you from?):

- Where do you come from? (not Where are you coming from?)
- He comes from Japan. (not He is coming from Japan.)
